UP's ethanol boom fuels Rs 30,000 Cr investment inflow

Uttar Pradesh has produced 182 crore litres of ethanol by November 2025, marking its highest output to date and solidifying its position as a leading ethanol producer in the country. Of this, 105.25 crore litres were sold within the state and 40.96 crore litres were supplied to other states, establishing UP as a significant supply hub for the biofuel.

This production surge is backed by substantial investment interest in the state's alcohol-based industrial sector. According to Excise



Commissioner Dr. Adarsh Singh, 125 investment agreements worth Rs 30,735 crore have been signed. The current project pipeline includes 43 ready-to-launch projects with land allotments involving Rs 6,898.88 crore, and 19 projects under the Invest UP initiative with over Rs 2,900 crore investment, which are expected to generate more than 4,800 jobs.
