Yamuna e-way emerges as UP ind backbone

Lucknow: Once seen merely as a highway linking Delhi and Agra, the Yamuna Expressway evolved into a cornerstone of UP's industrial and economic growth, said an official spokesperson on Monday.

Stating that the expressway emerged as a model of infrastructure-led development under chief minister Yogi Adityanath, the spokesperson said: "The expressway has transformed into more than a transport corridor—it now drives investment, job creation and planned urbanisation.
