

UP inks ₹25k-cr Essar MoU at Davos, steps up clean energy, digi push

Lucknow: The UP govt delegation attending the World Economic Forum (WEF) annual meeting secured a major investment commitment of Rs25,000 crore on Thursday by signing a high-value MoU with Essar Group. The alliance will significantly strengthen the state's clean energy, digital infrastructure and industrial growth pipeline, officials said.

An official spokesperson said: "The MoU with Essar Group, one of the largest investment commitments signed by UP during its Davos engagements, will focus on power and energy systems, logistics and warehousing, and data centres. The proposed in-
