

Govt committed to promote green energy, asserts Nandi

Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh is steadily advancing towards green energy and eco-friendly industrial development, industrial development minister **Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi'** said at the 5th Green Energy and Sustainability Conclave on Friday.

Addressing the event, organised by ASSOCHAM, Nandi highlighted that under the guidance of PM Narendra Modi and the leadership of CM Yogi Adityanath, the state has emerged on the national stage with a new identity and perception in in-



vestment and industrial growth. "Our govt is committed to promoting green energy, developing renewable energy, and creating an eco-friendly industrial ecosystem," he said.

The minister pointed out that the state's new solar policy has strengthened the renewable energy sector by offering incentives such as a 100 per cent stamp duty exemption for solar plants and a 100 per cent waiver on electricity charges for 10 years,

thereby attracting large-scale investment. "The double-engine govt provides step-by-step support to investors and entrepreneurs, ensuring a conducive environment for industrial growth," he added.

Nandi also stressed that Uttar Pradesh has transformed from the pre-2017 era of corruption into a model state for investment.
