

CM Yogi announces ₹2,000crore AI Mission in healthcare services

Lucknow: Announcing the launch of UP Artificial Intelligence Mission (UP-AIM), Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday said that the state will set aside Rs 2,000 crore for the mission to develop the state as a leader in the use of AI in healthcare services.

Speaking during the inauguration of two-day AI and Health Innovation conference, Yogi said, "Aligned with the goals set in India AI Mission, UP will now launch UP AIM (UP AI Mission). The state will set aside Rs 2,000 crore for the mission, to be implemented in a phased manner."
