

# CM: UP got investment proposals of ₹1L cr, inked ₹60k cr MoUs in S'pore

## 'Boost To Govt's USD 1 Trillion Economy Goal'

**Lucknow:** Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday said that during his 2-day visit of Singapore, UP govt received investment proposals of Rs 1 lakh crore, and the Invest UP team concluded MoUs worth around Rs 60,000 crore.

Addressing a press conference in Singapore after concluding the visit, Yogi called these proposals a milestone in govt's efforts to make UP a USD 1 trillion economy and added that investors were aware of the improvements and developments in UP, which gave them the confidence to collaborate with state govt. The CM and UP delegation will now leave for Ja-

Describing the two days he spent in Singapore, the CM said that he was in meetings from 8.30am till late at night. In addition, meetings were held with chairpersons and CEOs of major fintech companies, he said.
