

CII hosts SA envoy to boost trade ties

Prof Anil Sooklal highlighted the growing presence of Indian companies across sectors in South Africa, reflecting strong economic ties. He identified energy, particularly renewable energy and green hydrogen, as a priority area for collabo-

ration. He added that negotiations towards a free trade agreement between India and South Africa are underway and expected to unlock new trade and investment opportunities.

Industry members also discussed cooperation in agriculture, food processing, manufacturing, skills, infrastructure and sustainable development, expressing interest in joint ventures and institutional partnerships.
