

Yogi's five-day tour to Japan, Singapore to seek investment

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath will be on a five day tour of Singapore and Japan, where he will meet with Indian diaspora, industry experts and government officials to seek investment for UP and extend cultural and economic ties.

The CM, accompanied by senior government officials and members of Invest UP, is scheduled to depart for the tour on Feb 22. Government sources said that road shows will be held in both countries where Yogi will interact with the Indian diaspora, specifically those from
