

On Day 1 of CM's Japan visit, UP signs MoUs worth ₹11,000cr

Major Sectors Include Real Estate, Infra, Automobiles

Lucknow: On the first day of the three-day visit of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath to Japan, the Uttar Pradesh govt signed MoUs worth Rs 11,000 crore.

A govt spokesperson said that the companies with whom the MoUs were inked included Kubota Corporation, Minda Corporation, Japan Aviation Electronics Industry, Nagase & Co Ltd, Seiko Advance, O&O Group, Fuji Japanese JV, and Fuji Silvertch Concrete Pvt Ltd.

The collaboration between these companies and the UP Govt will focus on sectors such as agricultural equipment manufacturing, industrial machinery manufacturing, water and environmental infrastructure solutions, automobiles, electronics, industrial printing and graphics, hospitality and real estate.
