

CM Yogi signs ₹1.5L cr MoUs during Singapore-Japan visit

Inks Deal With Japanese Firm On Green Energy Tech

Lucknow: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath concluded his four-day visit to Singapore and Japan on Thursday after signing MoUs worth Rs 1.5 lakh crore. Besides, the delegation led by him received investment proposals worth Rs 2.5 lakh crore.

On Thursday, the last day of the Japan leg, the delegation signed an MoU with Japan's Yamanashi Prefecture on green hydrogen technology. The MoU also lays stress on enhancing cooperation in the fields of industry, tourism and vocational education and technological exchange.

“Under the agreement, students from higher technical institutions of Uttar Pradesh will receive training in Japan, and the technology will be implemented in the state’s industry, public transport and energy sectors. This will prove to be an important step towards achieving Prime Minister Modi’s ‘Net

Zero target,’” Yogi said after visiting the advanced hydrogen energy plant in Yamanashi.

The CM described the MoU as a symbol of clarity and trust and expressed his gratitude to the Yamanashi administration.
