

Sultanpur to get logistics, mfg cluster

Lucknow: Sultanpur will get an Integrated Manufacturing and Logistics Cluster (IMLC) at an estimated cost of Rs 272.25 crore, with the project to come up close to Purvanchal Expressway under the state's industrial corridor plan.

The state cabinet, chaired by chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday, approved the infrastructure development proposal for the cluster. The entire expenditure on the construction work will be borne by the state govt alone.

Officials said the cluster is expected to provide an industrial and logistics base for manufacturing units in Sultanpur and surrounding areas, leveraging its proximity to Purvanchal Expressway.

Following the cabinet approval, a global tender will be invited to select the agency for executing the infrastructure works.
