

UP-Yamanashi to work in several areas including green hydrogen: Kotaro Nagasaki

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Yamanashi Prefecture Governor Kotaro Nagasaki said that the relationship between Uttar Pradesh, Yamanashi Prefecture, and Japan will be strengthened in the long run.
