

UP cabinet approves letters of comfort for 11 projects worth ₹5,504cr

Lucknow: The state cabinet on Tuesday approved the issuance of Letters of Comfort (LoC) for 11 industrial projects including three foreign companies with a proposed investment of Rs 5,504.01 crore across nine districts.

The projects span food processing, bio-energy, paper, packaging, plastics, beverages and manufacturing, and are located outside the state's traditional industrial hubs.

Briefing reporters, industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi said cabinet members were informed that LoCs would help expand industrial activity and create jobs in underserved areas.

He said the projects would strengthen the industrial base in Gautam Buddh Nagar, Hamirpur, Hathras, Barabanki, Lakhimpur

Kheri, Mathura, Unnao, Bijnor and Kanpur Dehat.

Nandi added that the LoCs would facilitate further progress of the projects and signal the govt's commitment to supporting investors. The minister said implementation was expected to generate direct and indirect employment and open opportunities for ancillary industries and services in the districts. The approvals align with the govt's push to move proposals toward execution and broaden industrial growth statewide.
