MSMEs boosting employment and economy in Uttar Pradesh

Under the new MSME Act, MSME units can start operations within 72 hours of application with the state government, to this end; the state government shall issue Acknowledgement Certificate to the units within 72 hours of application.

To help the struggling MSMEs, the Uttar Pradesh government has introduced the Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) scheme, providing financial assistance and operational support. The Udyam Sarathi App, offers comprehensive guidance on business-related information,
