

Ayodhya airport now connected with nine cities within a month

Lucknow: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Thursday flagged off non-stop domestic SpiceJet flights connecting Ayodhya with seven different destinations.

These destinations include Ahmedabad, Chennai, Darbhanga, Delhi, Jaipur, Patna and Mumbai. From Friday, the airline will also add an eighth destination when it launches flights from Bengaluru.

After Dec 30 inauguration by PM Modi, Ayodhya airport now has flight services from three domestic airlines, including IndiGo and Air India, connecting Lord Ram's town with nine destinations, including Kolkata, within a month.
