A workshop on PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan held in Lucknow on Thursday

Lucknow: Invest UP, in collaboration with the ministry of commerce and industry and remote sensing applications centre, Uttar Pradesh (RSAC-UP), hosted a workshop on Thursday dedicated to enlightening state government officials on Prime Minister Gati Shakti National Master Plan. This initiative aimed to enhance project planning and expedite decision-making by leveraging available data and integrated infrastructure layers within the PM Gati Shakti portal.

Key figures in attendance included Abhishek Prakash, secretary of infrastructure & industrial development department and CEO of Invest UP, along with Vinod Kumar Verma, deputy director general of the department for promotion of industry and internal trade (DPIIT), among others. The workshop provided insights into the

Prime Minister Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP), with detailed discussions led by experts.

Over 100 officers and technical staff from more than 50 departments and affiliated agencies of the state government participated in the workshop. The presentation on the progress of PM Gati Shakti NMP in the state emphasised collaboration among departments and outlined expectations for successful implementation in Uttar Pradesh.

On the occasion, Abhishek Prakash pointed out the pivotal role of the PM Gati Shakti portal in advancing planning processes, streamlining inter-departmental coordination, and expediting project implementation. He highlighted that under PM Gati Shakti NMP, the portal integrates 24 mandatory layers, authenticated for accuracy, along with an additional 55 layers, further enhancing its functionality.
