

PM virtually inaugurates Agra Metro, CM Yogi takes first ride

AGRA: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday virtually inaugurated the Agra Metro project almost nine months ahead of schedule. The Agra Metro is now the sixth metro running in Uttar Pradesh. The virtual inauguration was done from Kolkata.

Chief minister Yogi Adityanath flagged off the Agra Metro from Taj Mahal Metro Station and took the maiden ride till the Taj Mahal Eastern Gate. He was accompanied by public representatives.

The chief minister congratulated residents of Agra on receiving this gift before Holi.
