Bhadohi and Azamgarh get major push for devpt

Lucknow: Large-scale initiatives are underway to drive economic and regional transformation in Bhadohi and Azamgarh to align them with future needs, an official spokesperson said on Wednesday.

"To rejuvenate Bhadohi's economic landscape, the Bhadohi Industrial Development Authority (BIDA) commenced work on a comprehensive vision document. A specialised team is being formed to conduct an in-depth analysis of the district's key economic sectors, focusing on infrastructure, transportation, industrial clusters and digital advancement," the spokesperson stated.

Adding that the process will begin with an inception report, the spokesperson further said: "The report will be followed by a detailed regional study culminating in a strategic blueprint for sustainable growth. Under the investment promotion policy, a participation report will incorporate expert recommendations to attract potential investors and stakeholders. This entire initiative is set to be completed within six months."

Talking about Azamgarh, he said: "The Azamgarh Development Authority (ADA) spearheads a geographic information system (GIS) based regional development framework as part of Master Plan 2031. Covering a 114-square-kilometre radius, this six-phase initiative will facilitate large-scale projects in industrial expansion, infrastructure enhancement and traffic management."

Noting that the process includes creating a geo-database, developing a GIS-based zonal plan and implementing zoning strategies aligned with govt policies, the spokesperson said: "Ground verification, mapping and policybased financial facilitation will also be key components of this structured approach. By integrating visionary planning with strategic execution, the Yogi govt is paving the way for sustainable and dynamic economic progress in Bhadohi and Azamgarh."
