

Dorna deal done, UP set to host MotoGP race for 3 yrs

Lucknow: The Uttar Pradesh govt will host the prestigious MotoGP race event for three years, starting 2025.

The announcement was made on Thursday after UP govt inked a deal with Dorna Sports, the commercial rights' holder for the motorcycling sport of Grand Prix racing.

The partnership was sealed in an agreement between Invest UP and Dorna Sports SL. While chief secretary and infrastructure industrial development commissioner of UP, Manoj Kumar Singh represented the state, Carmelo Ezpeleta signed the agreement for Dorna. The MotoGP races, one of the most watched

sporting events of the world, will take place at the Buddh International Circuit in Greater Noida, which has already hosted Formula 1 race in 2011 and MotoGP in 2023.

Industry experts are of the view that the move will help in positioning the state as the preferred destination for international events and investments.
