Govt sets targets for Viksit UP by 2047

Lucknow: In order to meet its targets for 'Viksit UP' by 2047, the state govt has identified major goals it needs to achieve under 12 sectors. A major challenge before it is to sustain the growth rate of 15-16% for the next 22 years to become a USD 6 trillion economy by 2047. This target should be met in addition to a per capita income of Rs 26 lakh by the same year.

Principal secretary, planning, Alok Kumar said that the govt of India has set a target of becoming a USD 30 trillion economy by 2047. Going by projections, UP should have a share of 17% in population and therefore should aspire to a 20% share in GDP, which is USD 6 trillion.

"Over the past three years, we have had a growth rate of about 15% and we need to sustain this. It is difficult but doable, considering UP is starting with a low base and we have a demographic dividend on our side," he said.

The govt has divided its strategic targets for 2030 and 2047 under 12 sectors, including agriculture, industry, women, tourism, housing, etc. As per plans, UP should be first in India for crop productivity and agricultural exports by 2030 and should aim to be among the global leaders in agri-exports. This will be done through improved agricultural productivity, export promotion, better storage facilities, crop diversification, use of technology, better processing, innovation, and sustainable agriculture.

By 2030, UP should also be the highest milk producer and have a 10% share in egg production and a 15% share in inland fish production. By 2047, it will aim to be a global leader in animal husbandry through means like conservation of national breeds, genome selec-

Govt focuses on security and good governance to realise Viksit UP goal

With Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath stating that only a safe, fearless and fair Uttar Pradesh can serve as the foundation of a Viksit Bharat, security and good governance would be the key focus of the state govt in realising the goal of Viksit UP-2047.

To promote investment, better accessibility and transparent and fair practices, the govt is carrying out several projects and schemes.

As per the Vision Document, the govt aims to establish modern command and control centres in every district by 2030, prepare district-level development and master plans, and provide high-speed broadband connectivity to every household and institution. By 2047, the state plans to achieve global standards in road safety, move towards a 'zero accident' situation, and create a fully transparent and accountable governance system.

To set its goals, the govt has adopted the principles of smart governance, smart policing,

tion, and production of export-oriented fish.

Through the development of aerospace, defence, apparel, EV batteries, and semiconductors, UP also aims to be first in FDI and manufacturing by 2047. By 2030, its software exports should be five times the current amount and the state should host 20 unicorns by then.

Capitalising on its cultural and spiritual heritage, UP aims to host 100 crore visitors annually by 2047, have at least 10 UNESCO World Heritage sites against three currently, and five global standard circuits. As part of improvement in cities, the state has set a target of being 35% urbanised by

and zero tolerance, focusing on real-time monitoring, road safety enforcement, ease of doing business, strict action on crime and corruption and police modernisation.

The govt will ensure the safety of every citizen through smart policing, expand the network of CCTV cameras. Al-driven surveillance and modern command centres across all districts. It will establish transparent and accountable governance through e-governance platforms and AI-based decision-making systems and monitor development projects and resource utilisation through an integrated real-time dashboard.

2030 and 60% by 2047. By 2030 itself, there should be 100% coverage through water supply and pucca housing coverage. By 2047, UP should be prominently urbanised and at least three cities from here should feature among the world's 50 most liveable cities.

In addition to this, all districts should have 100% connectivity through expressways while there will be one international airport in each of the 18 divisions. In addition to this, the govt would like more than 4 crore skilled workforce with global employability ready by 2047 and the state to be a major exporter of skilled talent in IT, healthcare, and manufacturing.
