UP earns 'Top Achiever' status in 2 categories in BRAP-2022



Lucknow: The <u>Uttar Pradesh</u> govt bagged the "Top Achiever" status in two categories of the Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP) 2022 announced in New Delhi on Thursday.

While total implementation of BRAP 2022 recommendations was the first

category enhancing ease of doing business was the other.
