Lucknow: Uttar Pradesh has bagged the "Top Achiever" status in two categories of the Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP) 2022 announced in Delhi on Thursday. UP won in two categories: total implementation of BRAP 2022 recommendations and ease of doing business.

Under BRAP 2022, a total of 352 reforms were recommended, covering different aspects of business regulation and citizen services.
