

# CM Yogi, British envoy discuss colab in business, EVs & higher education

**Lucknow:** Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath met British High Commissioner Lindy Cameron at his official residence in Lucknow on Thursday. Cameron, an Oxford graduate and former CEO of the UK National Cyber Security Centre, was appointed as the British High Commissioner to India earlier this year and is the first woman to hold the post.
