UP to produce over 22,000MW of solar power by 2027: Yogi

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said on Thursday that UP had set a target of producing over 22,000 MW of solar power by 2027 under its Solar Energy Policy 2022. 2024. Under the solar policy, the govt was looking at the development of solar parks, solarising agricultural feeders and private on-grid pumps, installing solar plants along expressways and railway tracks, and promoting the manufacturing of solar energy equipment.

Under the PM Surya Ghar Yojana, Yogi said over 10 lakh applications were received and more than 1 lakh installations were already completed.
