

Noida-Faridabad in 15 mins! Expressway to link key Haryana locations to Jewar Airport

The Faridabad-Jewar Expressway, a key infrastructure project, will cut travel time between Faridabad and Jewar Airport. Construction began in June 2023 and will complete by June 2025. It will improve connectivity for surrounding cities and support the airport's April 2024 launch.



Greater Noida: In a significant boost to regional infrastructure, Uttar Pradesh is set to unveil the Faridabad-Jewar Expressway, a state-of-the-art project aimed at transforming travel in the region. This new expressway will not only enhance connectivity to the under-construction Jewar Airport in Noida but also slash commute times dramatically, marking a milestone in the state's transportation landscape.

Currently, the 90-kilometer journey between Faridabad and Jewar takes two to three hours. The new expressway will reduce this distance to just 31 kilometers, enabling commuters to cover it in an impressive 15 minutes. This groundbreaking development promises seamless access to Jewar Airport for residents of Faridabad and surrounding areas, significantly improving travel efficiency for thousands of passengers.

Jewar-Faridabad Expressway to commence operations by June 2025

The expressway project, supervised by the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI), commenced construction in June 2023. Officials have set an ambitious deadline for completion by June 2025, aligning with the expected operational launch of Jewar Airport. Once complete, the expressway will connect Sector 65 in Faridabad directly to the airport, creating a critical transport corridor.

The Faridabad-Jewar Expressway is anticipated to benefit not only Faridabad but also key urban hubs like Gurugram, Noida, Greater Noida, and Delhi. By improving connectivity across Haryana and Uttar Pradesh, the project is expected to ease commuter congestion and boost economic activity. Experts suggest the expressway will foster regional integration, attract investments, and encourage business growth, further enhancing the area's development.

Noida Airport: Ticket sales to go live next months; operations set to begin in April

In a related development, the Noida International Airport in Jewar prepares to open its doors. Starting February, travelers can begin booking flights, with operations officially kicking off on April 17. The inaugural day is set to be a busy one, with 30 flights scheduled to take off. Among these, three will connect passengers to international destinations like Singapore, Zurich, and Dubai, while 25 domestic routes will cater to cities across India. The airport will also introduce two cargo operations, boosting the region's logistics and trade potential.
