New Delhi: Maha Kumbh Mela, the world's largest religious congregation that got underway this week in Prayagraj, is also turning out to be one of the biggest events in creating gig and temporary jobs.

Staffing and recruitment services firms estimate the 45-day festival to generate around a million such jobs.
