Yogi Adityanath on Wednesday gave in-principle consent for the construction of an International Exhibition-cum-Convention Centre in Lucknow, which will feature world-class facilities.

During a meeting with senior gov officials, the Chief Minister discussed the format, construction process, and cost of the proposed centre. He emphasised the need for a well-equipped, high-tech facility to host events of national and international significance in Lucknow, the spokesperson added.

The convention centre should be developed jointly by the Housing & Development Board and Lucknow Development Authority (LDA), with financial support from the state govt.
