The plant has collaborated with adjoining Jawaharpur Thermal Power Plant to process 100 per cent of the fly ash from the power plant, effectively recycling industrial waste and enhancing operational efficiency.

The facility is also equipped with robust pollution control systems to keep emissions well below regulatory norms.
