

UP's GDP to hit ₹32L cr by Mar next year: Yogi

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Wednesday said that due to govt's policies, zero tolerance towards crime and steps to boost industrialization, the state's GDP is projected to touch Rs 32 lakh crore.

Speaking at a round table conference organised by a media organization in Lucknow, the CM said that previous govts operated under 'One District, One Mafia' policy, his govt ensured the growth of MSMEs through 'One District, One Product' initiative.

"The state's GDP, which stood at Rs 12 lakh crore under previous govts, reached Rs 26 lakh crore in 2023-24,

with target of Rs 32 lakh crore for March 2025," he said.

Speaking about the strict stance of his govt against crime, the CM spoke about the zero-tolerance policy and said, "Our govt responds to criminals and mafia with the same severity that they use against citizens."
