U.P. has largest MSME base in country: CM

LUCKNOW/GREATER NOIDA: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Wednesday said Uttar Pradesh has the largest Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME) base in the country, emphasising that this sector is the second-largest job creator after agriculture and has played a significant role in the state's transformation into an industrial powerhouse.

He was addressing the gather-

ing at the inaugural function of the U.P. International Trade Show-2024 at the India Expo Center and Mart in Greater Noida.

"According to a survey, there are 96 lakh MSME units spread across 75 districts in the state," he said.
