

SETTING UP OF NEW FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES

The Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) does not set up food processing industries in its own. However, it facilitates setting up of such industries through its Central Sector Financial Assistance (CSFA) Scheme, Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme, Production Based Incentive (PBI) Scheme and Centrally sponsored PLI formulation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFE) scheme across the country including Bihar. These schemes are not region or state specific but demand driven and application based for financial assistance through Empowerment of Farmers across the country including Bihar.

Under PMFE, credit linked financial assistance (capital subsidy) is provided to entrepreneurs for setting up of food processing industry with total outlay of Rs 5120 Cr for 1500 Finance Commission Cycle.

Under PLI/PBI scheme, financial technical and business support is provided for setting up /upgradation of micro food processing enterprises. The scheme is operational for a period of upto 2025-26 with an outlay of Rs 10,000 crore.

PLI/PBI, on other side, intended to support creation of global food manufacturing champions and support Indian brands of food products in international market. The scheme is operational for a period from 2021-22 to 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs 10,000 crore.

MoFa Park and Biotech have been discontinued by the Ministry since 01.01.2021. Under APC Scheme, grants-in-aid (25% of eligible project cost) as General Area and grants-in-aid (50% of eligible project cost) in Difficult Areas as well as SC/ST PFOs, SHGs, subject to max. Rs. 10 lakhs per project is provided to eligible entrepreneurs.

The details of food processing industries approved for financial assistance under PMFSY and PMTME schemes of MoFPI across the country including Bihar is placed at Annexure.
